Please Note:

- New applications to the sailing program are processed in the order in which they are received, as determined by the postmark.
- Junior sailors who are returning for a consecutive season will be shown enrollment priority ***only*** if their forms are received by the **April 30, 2026** deadline. After that date, it will be considered a “new” application to the sailing program.
- Discount applies ***only*** to “sailing class and racing team” tuition, and ***does not*** apply to membership dues.

- Tuition for Sailing & Racing is lower if you are a Full Member of AYC. ●

AYC will make every effort to place your child in the class of your choice.

- Age and ability/previous sailing training are both considered in making class assignments.
- Final decisions regarding placement rest with the club.
- If your child is accepted, we will send you a copy of the Junior Sailor & Parent Handbook, and ask that you complete the required forms.
